Notes:

* All events (including 60M Dash and 60M Hurdles) will be timed finals; there are no trials/finals.

* For relays, athletes do not need to be from the same club or school. All-star relays will be allowed.

* Shot Put and Long Jump will allow 6 attempts per athlete.

* For High Jump, if youth (14-under) want to participate – they will need to enter in the High School meet for this event. We will begin at low enough opening heights for all athletes to participate.

Facility Information: The indoor facility is a regulation 200-meter Mondo track, with 6 lanes around the oval and 8 lanes on the straightaway. Spikes should be no longer than 1/4" pyramids.
